# The Fraternity of Montligeon: praying, and engaging people to pray, for the deceased

The main purpose of the Fraternity of Montligeon is to pray for the most forgotten among deceased people, the “forsaken souls of the Purgatory”. In addition, and ever since its foundation by Fr. Buguet in 1884, the Fraternity brings together all its enrolees or people recommended to its prayer - whether still living or having passed away - in a consistent spiritual communion. All enrolees’ names - whether still living or deceased - are listed in the registers placed in the obituary cabinet housed within the basilica.

## Perpetual Mass

Members of the Fraternity of Montligeon, whether self-enrolled or having been recommended to it, benefit from the perpetual Mass celebrated daily to their intent since 1884.

## Prayer Fraternity

Beside daily prayers from the Shrine, enrolees in the Fraternity of Our Lady of Montligeon also benefit from the prayer of its dedicated Prayer Groups. Presently they amount to 900 and represented in 45 countries throughout the world.

Enrolling someone, or oneself, in the Fraternity of Montligeon is securing one with the perpetual Mass celebrated daily at the shrine, and throughout the world, by means of the Montligeon associate prayer groups.

Enrolling a deceased person in the Fraternity is a way of demonstrating one’s love for them beyond death.

Enrolling a living person in the Fraternity - for example, for a special occasion such as a birth, for a first communion, a wedding, or for people in distress or indifferent to God - is a spiritual present that will endure forever, even after they have passed away.

You also have the right to object, rectify, use portability and limit the processing extend of your data. You may also file a complaint with the CNIL. Recording your data is required in order to take your request into account.
