On 8th December 2020, to mark the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church, Pope Francis launched the Year of St. Joseph. Also offered six occasions of receiving the special plenary indulgences

Pope Francis invites all this year to find inspiration in Saint Joseph in the view of strengthening their faith, and assenting to the will of God. Furthermore, the Church offers plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions, i.e. sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father. Six occasions indicated by the Apostolic Penitentiary.

1_ A plenary indulgence when meditating on Saint Joseph, the man of faith

"Saint Joseph, an authentic man of faith, invites us to rediscover our filial relationship with the Father." Meditate the "Our Father" for at least for 30 minutes or participate in a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph, and be granted a plenary indulgence.

2_ A plenary indulgence when meditating on Saint Joseph, the just man

"The virtue of justice practiced by Saint Joseph (...) is full adherence to divine law, which is the law of mercy." Perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy" and attain the gift of the plenary indulgence.

3_ A plenary indulgence when meditating on Saint Joseph, guardian of the Holy Family

"Saint Joseph's vocation was that of being the guardian of the Holy Family of Nazareth" where prevailed an "atmosphere of intimate communion, love and prayer." The plenary indulgence is granted for the recitation of the Holy Rosary in families and among the betrothed.

5_ A plenary indulgence when meditating on Saint Joseph, during the flight to Egypt

"The flight of the Holy Family to Egypt shows us that God is there where man is in danger, where man suffers, where he runs away, where he experiences rejection and abandonment." Pray the litany of Saint Joseph, or some other prayer to Saint Joseph, for the persecuted Church and for the relief of all persecuted Christians.

4_ A plenary indulgence when meditating on Saint Joseph, the worker

The plenary indulgence is granted when entrusting one's work daily to the protection of Saint Joseph, and to invoke the intercession of the worker of Nazareth for unemployed people seeking work, and for dignified work for all.

6_ A plenary indulgence when meditating on Saint Joseph, the patron of the Church

The plenary indulgence is granted who shall recite any prayer legitimately approved, or any act of piety in honour of Saint Joseph, for example "To you, O Blessed Joseph", especially on 19th March and on 1st May, and on the 19th of every month and every Wednesday (the day dedicated to The Saint's memory, according to the Latin tradition).

A plenary indulgence for the elderly, the sick, the suffering

The plenary indulgence is granted to the elderly, the sick, and the agonizing, "who for legitimate reasons are unable to leave the house, and who, with a soul detached from any sin and in the intention to fulfil, as soon as possible, the three customary conditions", shall recite an act of piety in honour of Saint Joseph, faithfully offering to God their sufferings.

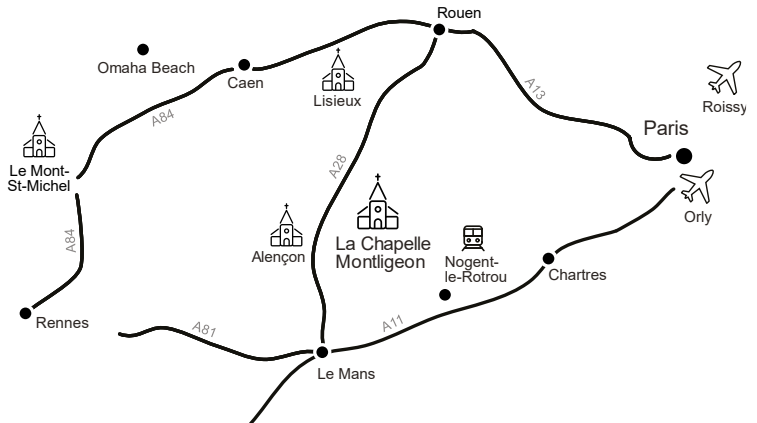
