Monsignor Paul-Joseph Buguet, parish priest of La Chapelle-Montligeon (Normandy, France) from 1878 to 1918, was the instigator of the "Expiatory Work for the forsaken souls in purgatory", today known as "Fraternity of Our Lady of Montligeon, Our Lady of deliverance of the poor souls".

The feast of Our Lady of Deliverance honours the Blessed Virgin Mary as she presents our prayers to her Son and intercedes for the departed. This Marian feast seeks to direct one's reflexion and prayer towards the most forsaken souls, and to remind that the zeal for the eternal salvation of all human beings, whether living or deceased, epitomizes the utmost charitable endeavour.

Hail blessed ever-Virgin Mary, who upheld the eternal Word! Gate of heaven, giving birth to God the Son, you unbolted the gates of heavens.

COLLECT

Almighty God,

through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, grant your mercy and forgiveness to the souls of the faithful departed, to the living, the bounty of your grace, and for all, everlasting life in the world to come.

Through Christ, Our Lord, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.
