How to write a postcard to a deceased person?

You can use this "Thank You/Sorry card", fill it in and forward it to us by electronic or postal mail; we will slip it on your behalf in the "letter-box" beneath the statue of Our Lady of Montligeon basilica.

To say "Thank you"...

It is vital to express our gratitude to our beloved departed: for their existence, for who they were, for what they taught us, for the good times we shared etc. Just as essential as expressing to the living why we love them.

To ask for forgiveness from or to forgive someone deceased

He is dead, she has departed. You did not have the opportunity to thank him/her. You did not ask him/her for forgiveness... Yet, in the communion of saints, we believe that we can still reach out to them, that the love bond is not severed but continues beyond death.
